<u>Goal</u>: Helping kids to know our catholic faith, embrace their faith, and share their faith with others.

<u>Who</u>: all CRECHE youth (ages 9 and older) are invited to sign up to join us in this performance.

<u>When</u>: Our performance will be at the <u>Epiphany talent show on Saturday, Jan</u> <u>5th</u> at <u>St Peter and Paul in Virgil</u>

You can expect:

The Kids will hear Scripture to support the messages found in this production. We will encourage them to develop their walk with God by reading the Bible and praying. We will talk about how to share the truth with others right where God has placed us. They will be learning to pray deeply for each other within the group and for those that will be coming to see the performance. Kids who have been in our theatre troupe will be paired with new kids to foster inclusion and new friendships. We will also assign prayer partners within the group to foster deeper connections. We want kids to realize they can be a positive influence on one another.

<u>This year we will be performing a Human Video</u>. Human video is the act of portraying a story during a song. The props and scenery used are those that we can portray with the actors themselves. It is pantomime to the next level! Early human videos were more like pantomime done at youth conventions. Some churches use this as an avenue of ministry, now incorporating acrobatics and dance.

<u>Music selection</u>: We will be using a combination of three songs : Mary did you know, I will ever praise you, and I will praise the Lord

Costumes and Stage Presence

Each child needs to have a costume consisting of a black tee shirt, black pants (for modesty please do not wear tights or tight leggings), black socks. These clothes help to keep the audience eye on our face and body motion.

<u>Attendance:</u>

We ask that if your child signs up to be in this production that you make sure to have them at every practice possible (barring sickness of course) We have such a short time to pull this all together - we will need every practice time possible :O

Additionally DVD should also contain the rest of the talent show (for posterity of course) There will be a small fee for these DVDs - the cost to be determined.
