CRECHE recognizes the benefit of intellectual, spiritual, and physical enrichment opportunities for its member families. Clubs are youth-related, recurring activities, which may or may not require paid dues to sustain programming. There are both CRECHE sponsored and CRECHE approved club opportunities.

Four steps to proposing and and starting a CRECHE club:

- 1. Proposal for club submitted to leadership.
- 2. Leadership Review and approval
- 3. Advisory review and approval
- 4. Receiving signed proposal as go ahead to start club

CRECHE sponsored clubs

- CRECHE sponsored clubs are those which have received approval and/or endorsement of CRECHE leadership, and are facilitated by one or more registered CRECHE members. *Facilitators will have completed the Diocese of Rockford's safe environment training, Protecting God's Children (PGC), and will maintain the presence of at least two PGC-trained adults in supervisory roles at all times.
- Members of CRECHE sponsored clubs must also be from registered CRECHE families.
- Dues or associated fees may be required for these clubs, which may be eligible to receive CRECHE funds to supplement said fees.
- Meetings or events for these clubs must be advertised online and must appear on the CRECHE Calendar on the CRECHE website.
- It is recommended that all clubs offered for CRECHE children under age 13 be CRECHE sponsored.
- All CRECHE sponsored club communication will be put out through CRECHE Leadership email.

CRECHE approved clubs

- CRECHE approved clubs are those clubs made available to CRECHE members and supported by CRECHE leadership as beneficial opportunities.
- These clubs will have at least one facilitator who is a registered CRECHE member and has completed the Diocese of Rockford's safe environment training, Protecting God's Children (PGC).
- Members of CRECHE approved clubs may or may not be from registered CRECHE families.
- Dues or associated fees may be required for these clubs, which usually will **NOT** be eligible to receive CRECHE funds to supplement said fees.
- Meetings or events for these clubs may be advertised online and may appear on the CRECHE Calendar and on the CRECHE website, with the approval of CRECHE leadership.
